Welcome to Big School, we are very pleased to see how well the children have settled in.

Letters and Sounds

Each week we will learn 4 new letter sounds. To help the children learn these sounds we would like you to talk to your child about which words begin with each sound. With your child please search at home for an object to bring in, it is very important that your child knows what they have brought in! Please make sure to write your child's name on the object so it does not get lost. If you can't find an object, your child could bring in a picture they have drawn. Please bring in an object/picture beginning with the sound on the following mornings...

Monday- s
Tuesday- a
Wednesday- t
Thursday- p



(eg. soap, apple, teddy, pig)

For School Your Child Needs...

- everything to be labelled with their full name (shoes, uniform, lunchbox, water bottle, PE kit, book bag, coat)
- a full named PE kit on their peg all week (this can be taken home to be washed on Fridays if you wish)
- a full spare named uniform including underwear on their peg
- a named water bottle for the classroom containing water (not juice!) If your child has a packed lunch they will need an additional drink.

Forest School

Our Forest School sessions take place on 'The Patch' which is an enclosed natural environment on our school field. The sessions are designed to support the relationship between the children and the natural world. We teach the children how to use tools safely on a one-to-one basis and provide opportunities for them to take supported risks such as tree climbing.

If you also have a passion for the outdoor natural environment and would like to support these sessions please let a member of the team know.

For a Forest School session your child will not need to wear their school uniform. We would like the children to come to school wearing clothes that are suitable for the weather **that you do not mind getting dirty**. A tracksuit and welly boots would be perfect.
