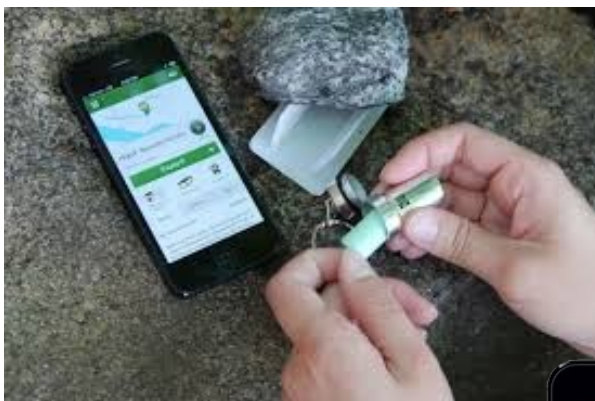




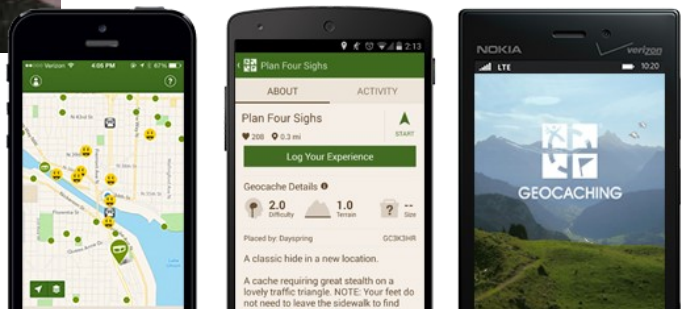
Out and About Challenge 2

This week, when you're out for your daily exercise, why not have a go at geocaching? Geocaching is a bit like a real life treasure hunt, using GPS co-ordinates to find a container or a micro/ nano cache with a logbook or swappable item. Use your map reading knowledge to see if you can find the caches hidden in the local area (do not remove them!).



First you will need to ask your grown-up to download the app on their smartphone. Look out for the symbol above. This app is free (you do not need to pay for the premium upgrade).

The app will need to use your 'location'. Choose which geocache you want to find and click 'Navigate'. There's clues on there if you need.



Don't forget to take some hand-gel with you and make sure you wash your hands before you leave home and when you get in!
