- The teacher was as wise as an owl



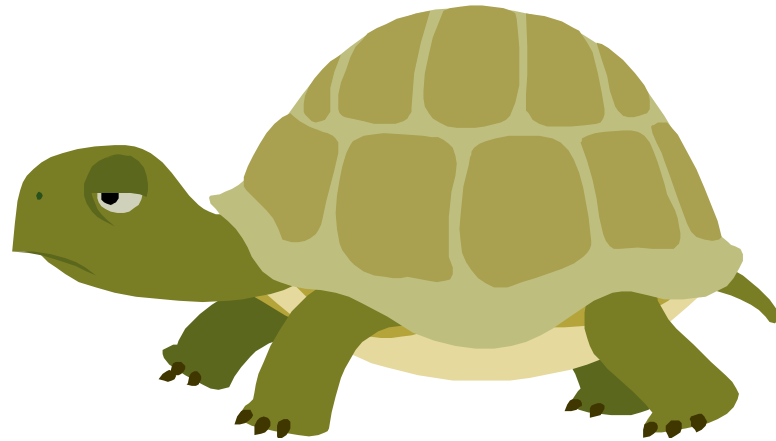
Similes

- The boy was as cheeky as a monkey



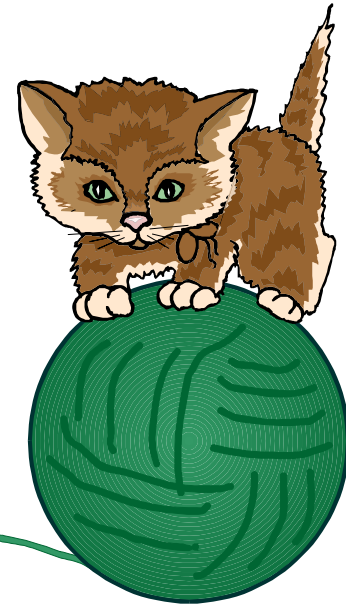
Similes

Those similes were describing **things**

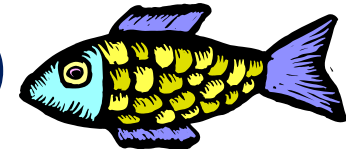
(as big as a house)

- He looks like an ogre



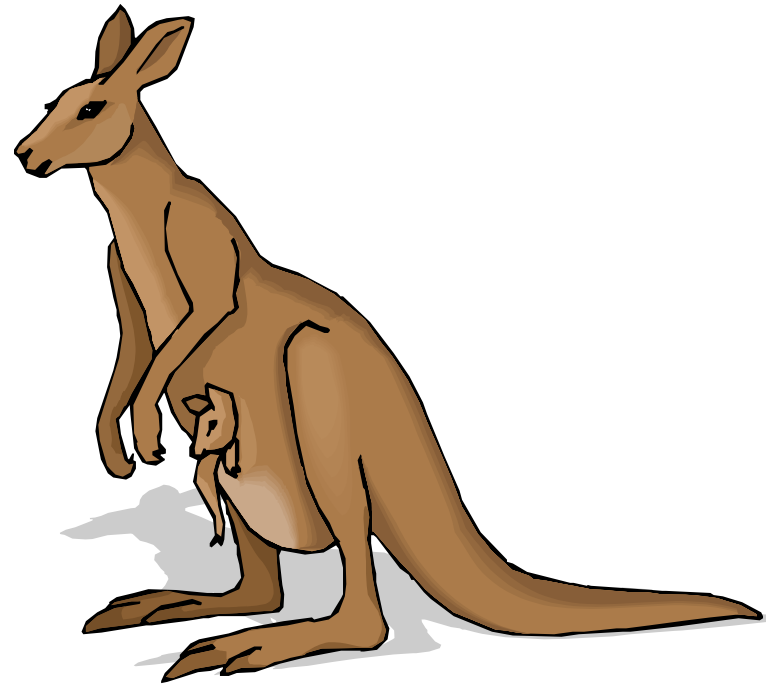
Similes
