We will be looking out on Tapestry for the most creative ways to write... for example your child could use paint, sticks, water, chalk, their fingers in sand, mud, etc.

For School Your Child Needs...

- everything to be labelled with their full name (shoes, uniform, lunchbox, water bottle, PE kit, book bag, coat)
- a full spare, named uniform including underwear and plimsolls on their peg
- a named water bottle for the classroom containing water (not juice!) If your child has a packed lunch they will need an additional drink.

Forest School

Our Forest School sessions take place on 'The Patch' which is an enclosed natural environment on our school field. The sessions are designed to support the relationship between the children and the natural world. We teach the children how to use tools safely on a one-to-one basis and provide opportunities for them to take supported risks such as tree climbing.

If you also have a passion for the outdoor natural environment and would like to support these sessions please let a member of the team know.

For a Forest School session your child will not need to wear their school uniform. We would like the children to come to school wearing clothes that are suitable for the weather **that you do not mind getting dirty**. A tracksuit and welly boots would be perfect.

The following groups will be going to 'The Patch' this half term and then the groups will change after the October half term. So don't worry if your child's name is not on the list!
