Terms of Reference - Curriculum Committee

INTRODUCTION

This committee will review and evaluate teaching and learning, pupil achievement and standards and the implementation of matters relating to the whole child. The committee will:

- Review and update, when necessary, the school's Curriculum Map giving due regard to SMSC
- Monitor and evaluate the school's obligations under the National Curriculum and pupils' attainment in academic and other areas
- Review the information about the school's achievement and attainment and attendance, and to ensure that the needs of all children, regardless of ability, are met
- review the policy and provision for collective worship and religious education and to make recommendations
- Review the policy and provision for sex education and make recommendations
- Review, after consultation with the Headteacher and staff, all policies and provision allocated to the Curriculum Committee
- Contribute towards the SEF and School Development Plan.
- Review Educational visits
- Ensure a schedule is in place for Governor Visits

AIMS

The committee has particular aims and objectives in respect of teaching, learning and pupil achievement and standards

MEMBERSHIP

The membership shall be reviewed at the start of each academic year.

MEETINGS

Quorum shall be **3 or 1/3** (whichever is greater) of members. Voting shall be by majority decision of the voting members.



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MINUTES

Meeting dates and agendas shall be notified to governors in advance, prior to committee meetings. Minutes shall be taken at each meeting and circulated to all members of the governing body. Approved minutes will also be available for inspection by staff, parents and members of the public on request (copies to be held in school file).
