Outdoor Equipment

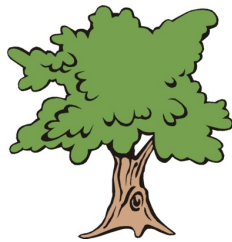
Please do not allow your child to play on the outdoor equipment before and after school. The school will not be insured if an accident happens.
