(eg. soap, apple, teddy, pig)

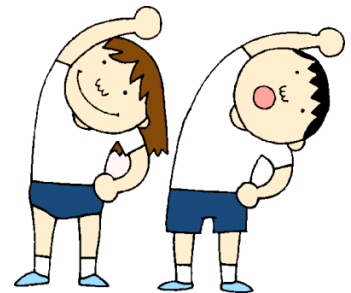


Meet the Team
